

QUICK FACTS* NEW MEXICO CLEAN DIESEL PROGRAM

Program Open/Close Date

- Program opened on February 1, 2023
- Program will close on December 31, 2023 or when grant funding is exhausted

Eligible Project Types

- Vehicle replacement, including installation of one charging unit per vehicle

Maximum Grant Amount

- NMED may fund up to 45% of the cost of a new all-electric replacement vehicle
- NMED may fund up to 50% of the cost of a replacement drayage truck

Funding

- FY23 = \$1.3 Million

Scrappage

- Yes, vehicle being replaced must be scrapped within 90 days of replacement

Leasing

- No funds awarded under this grant may be used for leased vehicles

Evaluation

- First come, first served
- Preference given to projects near and adjacent to non-attainment areas, economically disadvantaged areas, and areas subject to a high volume of diesel-fueled vehicles



Operation Requirements

- No funds awarded may be used to expand a fleet
- Replacement vehicle must operate within New Mexico at least 75% of the time

Existing Vehicle Requirements

- Existing vehicle must be fully operational and must have at least 3 years of remaining life at the time of upgrade
- Participating fleet owner must own and operate existing vehicle and have owned and operated it during the 2 years prior to upgrade
- Diesel Engine Model Year 2010 and newer may be replaced with new zero-emissions truck
