Maximum Grant Amount

- Maximum grant of \$410,000 for Zero-Emission New Truck Replacement Projects
- Grant awards are based on cost-effectiveness of harmful pollutants that will be reduced by the project and calculated by the district based on multiple factors

Funding

■ \$12.9 million granted by state

Co-Funding

 Cannot be stacked with HVIP, or other statefunded sources

Scrappage

Yes, existing vehicle must be destroyed

Leasing

Leased vehicles do not qualify for funding

Evaluation

- First-come, first served basis
- Pre-Inspection upon receipt of complete application
- Post-Inspection upon receipt of a claim for payment

Operation Requirements

- New vehicle must be registered within the District boundaries during the life of the project
- New truck must operate at least 75% of the time in California and 50% within District
- Remain the owner of the replacement truck for the life of the project
- Demonstrate that replacement truck is domiciled within the boundaries of the District
- Submit annual reports to the district

Existing Vehicle Requirements

- Engine Model Year that is 6 or more years of age.
 Projects funded in the calendar year of 2023 must have an engine model year that is 2017 or older
- Grant amounts will be based on the lowest total usage of two 12-month periods within California from the previous 30 months
- Existing vehicle must be owned by the applicant for the past 24 months
- Currently registered in California and registered in California for the past 24 months prior to application submission date
- Operate at least 50% of the time within the District boundaries, and at least 75% of the time within California for the past 24 months prior to the application submission date

Comments

- San Joaquin Valley AQMD is made up of eight counties in California's central valley: San Joaquin, Stanislaus, Merced, Madera, Fresno, Kings, Tulare and the San Joaquin Valley Air Basin portion of Kern
- Applicant must not purchase, make down payments, or take possession of replacement truck prior to issuance of a contract. Doing so will render a project ineligible
