# PA ALTERNATIVE FUELS INCENTIVE GRANT PROGRAM (AFIG)

#### PROGRAM OPEN/CLOSE DATE

- Program opened on June 30, 2023
- There are 2 application periods. The program will collect and review all applications submitted by 11:59PM on August 25, 2023 and again by 11:59PM on December 15, 2023

#### **ELIGIBLE PROJECT TYPES**

- Alternative fuel vehicle purchases; including electric and hydrogen ZEVs.
- Covers the incremental cost to purchase new alternative fuel vehicles

#### **FUNDING**

Approximately \$3 million in funding available to school districts, municipalities, nonprofit organizations, and businesses in Pennsylvania that want to transition to cleaner fuel transportation

# MAXIMUM GRANT AMOUNT

#### Class 8 BEV with capacity above 200 kWh

- 90% of incremental cost eligible for grant request
- Maximum grant award of \$100,000 per new vehicle

## Class 8 Hydrogen FCEV

- Up to 100% of incremental cost eligible for grant request
- Maximum grant award of \$40,000 per new vehicle

Note: This grant does not fund the total vehicle purchase cost.

Incremental Cost is defined as the difference in cost between the base price of a conventional model vehicle and its alternative fuel model related to use of the alternative fuel

### SCRAPPAGE

There is no scrappage requirement under AFIG

#### **LEASING**

Leased vehicles do not qualify for funding



#### **EVALUATION**

Competitive application process

### **OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

- Activities funded must be conducted in Pennsylvania. Vehicle usage should occur primarily in Pennsylvania.
- Vehicles funded must be registered in Pennsylvania and remain registered in the state for no less than 2 years after project completion.

### **PRIORITIES FOR GRANT FUNDING:**

- Businesses whose headquarters or principal place of business are located in Pennsylvania
- Zero-emission vehicle projects
- Projects located in or predominantly serving environmental justice areas
- Minority-, veteran-, or woman-owned businesses
- AFIG is a reimbursement grant program.
  Payment requests may begin only after the grantee has received a fully executed grant agreement
